- Maui Wowi provided sample smoothies to the meeting attendees. They would like to partner with the TAAB concessions team in selected larger events (Cheer and Robotics). Small, Medium and Large sizes available and per the cheer parents there is always a line to purchase. For a 16-20 team event, the revenue is usually \$2,000 and TAAB would get 15% of the revenue.

- There was discussion on a need for a new popcorn machine for inside concessions. Sam confirmed there are encumbered funds that could cover a new machine, Dave and Scott to discuss offline.
