Requirements to earn a \$175 Undergraduate Grant (Earn this year and redeem June 2023-April 2024)

- Pay Booster membership before earning any points → Cost is \$25/family
- Volunteer and earn a minimum of 8 points by **4/10/23** (April Booster meeting) → Parent/guardian/AHS student athlete/ sibling high school age or older earn 1 point per shift. (1 shift is typically 3-4 hours) Make sure to sign in legibly.

- Parent attends 2 TAAB meetings between August and April → Make sure to sign in legibly. Each meeting counts for all of your AHS student athletes.

- Student earns a 2.0 GPA or higher → Counseling office verifies student's GPA.

- Submit application by **4/10/23** (April Booster meeting) → Applicant must have participated in a freshman, JV, or varsity Athens sport, varsity club sport, or be an athletic trainer assistant/manager

Requirements to earn an additional \$175 Lead Grant

- Attend ServSafe & lead training → Lead grant points can be earned simultaneously with undergrad grant points. An undergraduate grant **MUST** be earned in order to qualify for a lead grant.
- Volunteer and earn a minimum of 8 lead points by **4/10/23** → Only parents/guardians can earn lead points. Each lead shift earns 1 point.

Using Your Undergraduate or Lead Grant earned in 2022/23 Booster year

- Student athlete receives grant letter at end of school year → Grant may be used for pay-to-participate, athletic training camps or travel league fees
- Pay your athlete's athletic expense and secure a receipt → This grant will reimburse you up to \$175 of athletic expenses paid. Expenses must be incurred between **June 2023 and April 2024**.
- Submit receipt to grant coordinator by **April 30th** → Receipt may be a paid invoice, canceled check or signed dated receipt from a coach. Receipt must state the camp or training, date of camp/training, amount, student name and date paid.

Requirements to earn a \$500 Senior Scholarship

Paid Booster membership during both junior and senior years.

Cost is \$25/family for each year

Volunteer and earn points by **4/10/23**. Tiered levels approved for **Class of 2023 ONLY**:

- 25-29.5 points - \$300
- 30-34.5 points - \$400
- 35+ points - \$500

Points can be accumulated all 4 years of high school as long as families are Booster members.

Parent/guardian/AHS student athlete/ sibling high school age or older earn 1 point per shift. (1 shift is typically 3-4 hours)
Make sure to sign in legibly.

★ **NEW THIS YEAR:** Senior Booster member families who are unable to meet the minimum point requirement for a senior scholarship may volunteer for 8 points exclusively during their senior year and earn a \$175 award. This award may not be combined with a senior scholarship, but may be combined with a separate lead grant.

Parent attends 2 TAAB meetings between August and April for both junior and senior years

Make sure to sign in legibly. Each meeting counts for all of your AHS student athletes.

Tiered levels approved for **Class of 2024 ONLY**:
30-34.5 points - \$400
35+ points - \$500

Student earns a 2.0 GPA or higher

Counseling office verifies student's GPA.

Senior Scholarship Requirements Reinstated

Class of 2025 & beyond:

35+ points - \$500

Class of 2026 & beyond:

Student applicant must volunteer for at least 4 of the required scholarship points.

Submit application by **4/10/23**
(April Booster meeting)

Applicant must have participated in a freshman, JV, or varsity Athens sport, varsity club sport, or be an athletic trainer assistant/manager

Senior scholarships are presented during the Athens Senior Honors Convocation in May

Students receiving an athletic scholarship from their college are responsible for ensuring that acceptance of an Athens Athletic Boosters scholarship does not impact their NCAA or collegiate eligibility.
